PPWR Compliance Supplier Form Packaging

Why are you receiving this form?

Allied Vintners International imports wine (and related products) from countries both inside and outside the EU. From 12 August 2026, the EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR, Regulation (EU) 2025/40) applies directly in all EU Member States. As an importer, we are legally required to verify that every packaging component: bottle, closure, label, box and pallet is accompanied by a valid EU Declaration of Conformity (DoC) and the underlying technical documentation, to retain these records (5 years for single-use packaging, 10 years for reusable packaging), and to be able to make them available to supervisory authorities within 10 days (Art. 18 PPWR). Without the information requested in this form, we cannot meet this obligation and the packaging may not be placed on the EU market.

This form collects the material, substance and documentation data that we require, regardless of whether you have already drawn up your own EU Declaration of Conformity. We kindly request that you complete this form in full and attach the requested documentation.
